## THE VINTAGE

2023 was full of contrats! Warm temperatures at the beginning of winter, then a return to normalcy until February; Spring was characterized by a persistent drought and strong wind, followed by regular rainfall until the end of June. Our winegrower partners have worked a lot in the vineyards to preserve the grapes. At the beginning of the harvest, berries were healthy and well-ripened, promising one of the finest vintages of the past decade.

#### TERROIR

Hills with light sandy soils, ancient scree terraces.

## WINEMAKING

Grapes are pressed and vinified separately. Maceration of 20-25 days with daily pumping-over at the beginning of the process. Fermentation under controlled temperatures.

#### **AGEING**

12 months in oak barrels.

#### **VARIETALS**

Grenache noir 50%, Syrah 35%, Carignan 15%

#### 14.5 % VOL.

Contains sulphites.

## SERVING

14-16°C

#### **TASTING**

Intense color of fresh cherry. Nose of raspberry, blackberry. Mouth of ripe & juicy fruits and spices. Soft tannins

Appetizers, grilled red meat, roasted vegetables...
